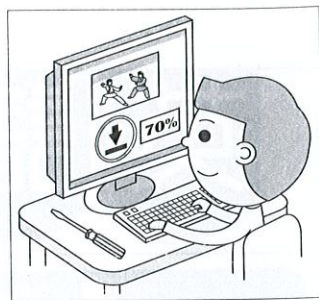

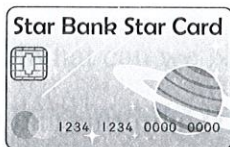

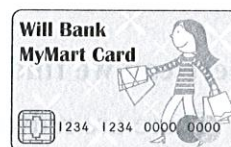

Redwoods

We care about redwoods, the tallest trees in the world. Because of the warming weather and heavy logging, there are much fewer redwoods on the Earth than in the 1850s. Here are some FAQs.

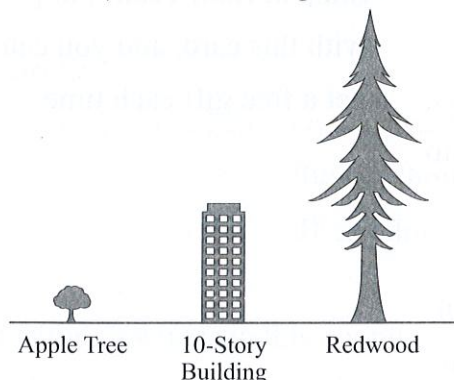
FAQ

* Where can we find redwoods in the world?

There are redwoods all over the world, but most of them are in California and Oregon in the USA.

* How long can a redwood live? How tall can a redwood grow?

Redwoods are famous for their longevity. They can live for more than 2,000 years although most of them only live for 500 – 700 years. A redwood grows 90 to 300 cm each year. The tree will stop growing when water can't get to the top of it. These old trees can be over 330 feet high (about 100 m). Here is the picture.



* How thick is the bark of a redwood?

The bark can be up to about 30 cm thick, and it holds a lot of water. Because of the thick bark, fires will not burn through the bark easily. The tannin-rich bark also keeps insects away. So, it helps redwoods grow more safely and live longer.


* What can we do to help save redwoods?

We can give away money to help save them. We can also tell others not to cut them down.

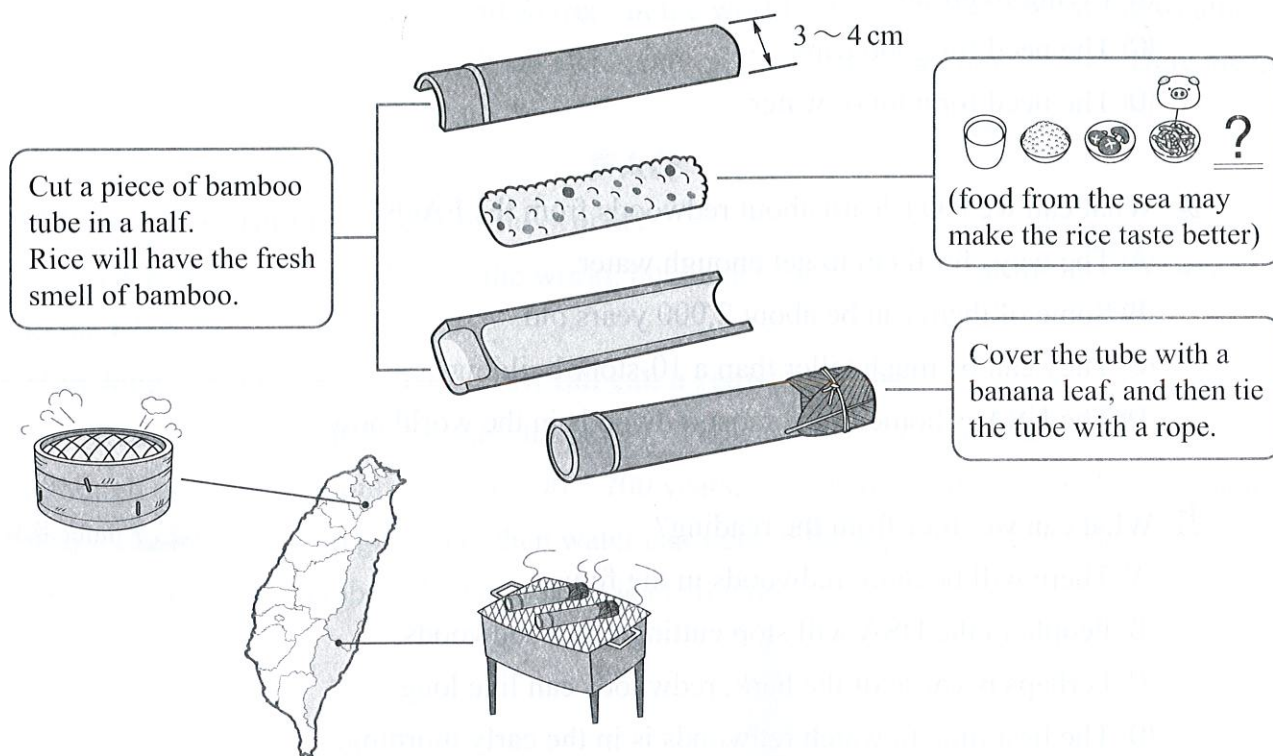

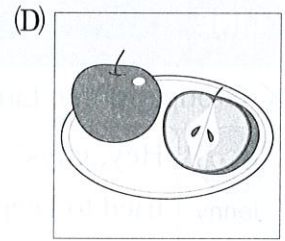
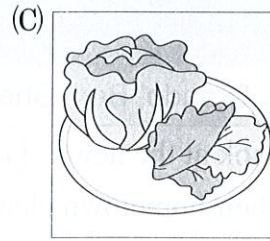
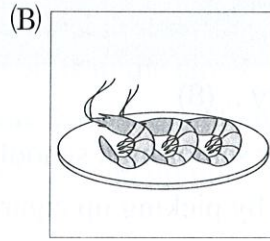
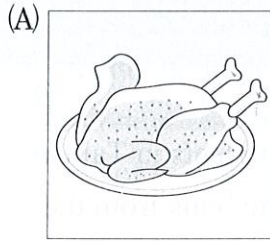


What do indigenous people call it?	De Lu Gu
