# The Day of the Dead 🎉

People from different countries see death in different ways. In Taiwan, we seldom talk about it even on Tomb Sweeping Day. In Mexico, people celebrate the Day of the Dead with joy. During the festival, they also sweep 1 tombs, but they remember their dead relatives in a **lively** way.

Two months ago, I visited my friend, Rosa, in Mexico. I was there for the Day of the Dead on November first and second. We invited the **ahosts**4 back to our world. We painted our faces and dressed up in costumes. **Later**<sup>5</sup>, we danced at a street party. It was so fun.

Back at Rosa's house, there were flowers, candles, candy<sup>6</sup>, and food on the table. Her family cooked a big meal<sup>7</sup> for everyone, and then shared<sup>8</sup> touching <sup>3</sup> stories<sup>9</sup> 25 of their dead relatives with me. For Mexicans, the Day of the Dead is all about love, not fear 4.
